ICON OF OUR LADY OF PERPET-UAL SUCCOUR: The original icon with this title came into being about 1455. Very soon it gained a reputation as a tremendous source of solace and healing ('succour' means 'to console at the breast'). Pilgrims flocked to it in their thousands. Believed destroyed after Napoleon's soldiers looted Rome, it was rediscovered in 1886 in a monasterv where it had been taken for safe keeping and forgotten about. It was restored to public veneration that same year in the Church of St. Alphonsus, Rome, where it remains to this day. It continues to be a source of great comfort for pilgrims from all parts of the world. Copies of the icon hang in many Catholic churches and

homes in the UK. 2016 marks the 150th anniversary of the icon's return to public veneration. For the Jubilee Year of Mercy, Fr. Bill has felt gently prompted (somehow!) to give a copy of the icon of Our Lady of Perpetual Succour a place in our beautiful church. He does not know why, but that is God's business. To that end, a lovely copy of the icon has been sourced from the Belarusian sisters who visited us earlier this year (was that a coincidence?). It will be enshrined in our Lady Chapel during Solemn Evening Prayer on Sunday 13th December at 4.00pm. At this service Fr. Bill will preach about the icon and fill us in on the promptings that have led him to give it a home among us. Please come.
