NEWSLETTER ITEM RE. ILLICIT MASSES IN BOURNEMOUTH AREA: You may have seen an advert in the local press offering 'Traditional Latin Mass' in private houses. Please be aware that these are not sanctioned by the bishop and the priest has no permission to operate in this diocese. At present, we have also been unable to verify that the priest has been validly ordained, although we know that he has not been through the diocesan vetting process regarding Safeguarding. The Form of Mass used is that offered pre-1950, not the 1962 Form that Pope Benedict sanctioned for use. They are not to be confused with the legitimate EF (Tridentine) Form Masses presently being offered at Our Lady immaculate Church, Westbourne and Sacred Heart Church, Bournemouth.
