JUBILEE HOLY DOORS IN THE YEAR OF MERCY

A **HOLY DOOR** traditionally refers to an entrance portal located within the Papal Major basilicas in Rome. They are ceremoniously opened during Jubilee years designated by the Pope, for pilgrims who enter through those doors to gain the plenary indulgences attached with the Jubilee year celebration.

In this Jubilee Year of Mercy, Pope Francis broke with tradition in having each Diocese throughout the world designate one or more local Holy Doors, so that pilgrims may gain the plenary indulgences without having to travel to Rome.

In the Diocese of Portsmouth, Bishop Phillip has designated two Holy Doors:

- St John's Cathedral, Portsmouth
- Our Lady and St Edmund of Abingdon, Abingdon
