SOLEMNITY OF Ss. PETER AND PAUL: Holiday of Obligation. Thursday, 29th June. On this day, we celebrate Ss Peter and Paul as the founders of the See of Rome, through their

preaching, ministry and martyrdom there. In the year 395, St. Augustine of Hippo wrote, *'Both apostles share the same feast day, for these two were one; even though they suffered on different days, they were as one...And so we celebrate this day made holy for us by the apostles' blood. Let us embrace what they believed, their life, their labours, their sufferings, their preaching and their confession of faith.'* Mass will be at **11.00am only**. There will be evening Masses, all at 7pm, at the following churches: The Annunciation, Charminster; Sacred Heart, Bournemouth, St Joseph and St Walburga, Poole.
