CENTENARY CELEBRATIONS FOR BLESSED OSCAR ROMARO: This year, 2017, is the centenary of the birth of Blessed Oscar Romaro. As Archbishop in El Salvador in the 1970s, Oscar Romero became increasingly outspoken about human rights violations, which ultimately led to his assassination in 1980 when he was shot whilst celebrating Mass.
