This Sunday is the first World Day of the Poor, instituted by Pope Francis as a way of inviting us to consider how sharing with those living in poverty 'enables us to understand the deepest truth of the Gospel.' In his message he asks all of us, whatever our means, to unite in love and in acts of service to one another. The **St. Vincent de Paul Society** does just that: it aims to tackle poverty in all its forms through the provision of practical assistance to those in need, irrespective of faith or ethnicity. And that is why, on this World Day of the Poor, we have invited Nina Lake, President of the SVP at Our Lady Immaculate, to give a short talk, at the end of both Masses, on the work of the Society.
