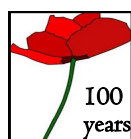


# PARISH OF OUR LADY IMMACULATE, WESTBOURNE

**ALL SAINTS DAY: Thursday 1st November. Holy Day of Obligation.** Mass will be at **11am only**. Evening masses at **7pm** on that day are at the Bournemouth Oratory, Bournemouth; Corpus Christi Church, Boscombe; the Annunciation Church, Charminster; and St. Josephs, Poole. You will find their addresses in the box at the bottom of this page.

**ALL SOULS DAY: Friday, November 2nd. 11am Mass.** After Mass, the church will remain open for anyone who would like to come and light a candle in remembrance of loved ones who have passed away. There will also be an opportunity to put their names in a basket which will be placed at the foot of the altar during 11am Mass on **Weds, 28th November**.



**ACT OF REMEMBRANCE: Sunday 11th November at 11am**, is poignantly the exact time 100 years ago that the First World War ended. At 11.00am, a parish Act of Remembrance will take place, followed by the laying of the wreath and two minutes silence.

**BAMENDA UPDATE:** *Bishop Phillip writes:* 'I was very saddened to hear that last week a first-year seminarian was shot dead by the military in Bamenda'. Gerard Anjiangwe was killed outside church after Mass. The present situation is an example of the increasingly negative attitude of the military towards the church there. Bishop Phillip, together with the Bamenda Team, hope to raise the profile of the problems in Cameroon with the international community and to enlist the help of our own government to bring pressure and assistance. In the meantime, we keep all the people of Bamenda in our prayers. Next Sunday, **November 4th**, there will be a special collection on **Bamenda Sunday**, giving us an opportunity to show our solidarity with them during this troubled time.
