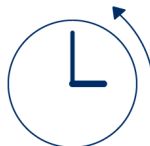
SCHOOL FORMS: All school admission forms requiring the priest's signature should be presented in person directly to Fr Andrew after Sunday mass.

PRO-LIFE

PROPOSED CHANGE TO ABORTION LAW:

On **Tuesday 23rd October**, Diana Johnson MP will bring forward a Ten Minute Rule Motion regarding a proposed change to the abortion law. The Johnson Bill is being presented as a move to introduce abortion access in Northern Ireland, but Right To Life campaigners argue that in reality it would have the effect of making the Abortion Act 1967, along with all the legal safeguards it provides, void through to at least 24-weeks.
