BAMENDA SUNDAY: Today. Two weeks ago a first-year seminarian was shot dead by the military in Bamenda outside church after Mass. This is just one example of the increasingly negative attitude of the military towards the church in Bamenda. Bishop Phillip, together with the Bamenda Team, hope to raise the profile of the problems in Cameroon with the international community and enlist the help of our own government to bring pressure and assistance. In the meantime, we keep all the people of Bamenda in our prayers. Today, there will be a special collection for **Bamenda Sunday**, giving us an opportunity to show our solidarity with the people of our twinned diocese, Bamenda, during this troubled time.
