OUR LADY OF WALSHINGHAM: Next year, on **25th March 2020**, the Feast of the Annunciation, England is going to be rededicated as the 'Dowry of Mary' and in preparation for this, the statue of Our Lady of Walsingham will be visiting every Cathedral in England for a three-day triduum of prayer. DIOCESAN PILGRIMAGE TO LOURDES July 2019: This will be led by Bishop Philip assisted in many aspects by young people from throughout the diocese who will lead music, catechesis, social activities, and help pilgrims with their mobility by offering a steadying hand or pushing a wheelchair. All pilgrims will stay at the Hotel La Solitude (bedrooms are air-conditioned, and there is a swimming pool) which is quite close to the Shrine on a full board basis.
