CANONISATION OF JOHN HENRY NEWMAN: Takes place today at St. Peter's, Rome. John Henry Newman is the first English person since the 17th century to be officially recognized as a saint by the Roman Catholic Church. Bishop Philip will come to the Bournemouth Oratory for a diocesan Mass of thanksgiving for his canonisation on **Friday, October 25th at 7.00pm.** Newman was the founder of the first Oratory Congregation in 1848. Prayer cards are available at the back of the church.
