FOOD BANK: Today is World Day of the Poor, designated by Pope Francis as a day to reflect on how poverty is at the very heart of the Gospel. In the UK, more than 14 million people are living in poverty - including 4.5 million children. Foodbanks provide emergency food and support to people in crisis, so please continue to do what you can to keep our own food bank topped up. The basic staple requirements are **breakfast cereal, dried pasta, orange juice (carton), soup (tinned or dry), tea bags. Also tinned meat, tuna, baked beans, vegetables, fruit, rice pudding and tomatoes (all tinned).** Please make sure that all are in date. *Many thanks.*

MASS INTENTIONS IN NOVEMBER: As well as All Souls Day on November 2nd, the entire month of November is traditionally dedicated as a time of prayer for the Holy Souls. If you would like to have a Mass offered for a loved one, please speak to Suzanne or Sara.
