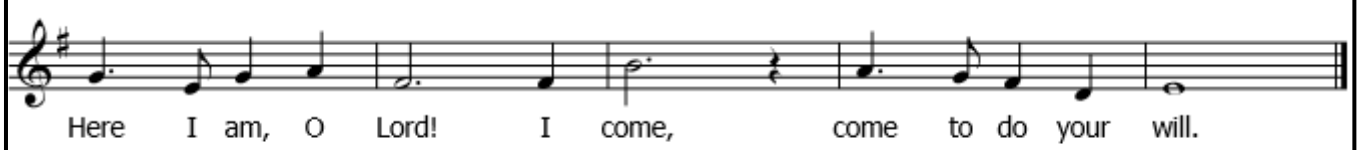

The idea comes from the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 27:18 – 28:10) when St Paul found refuge in Malta after a shipwreck, and calls on us
